It's important to include your pets in your estate plan to avoid disagreements and to protect them from going into a shelter. **Only 60%** of people have a will or living trust, and **only 9%** of those people have included their pets in their estate planning. You can set up a **pet life care agreement** for just the cost of a notary if you are leaving your pet to a family member and no funds are involved. Toothpaste Recipe for Dogs

Love to see your dog smiling? Keep that smile healthy with good dental care. It's good for their teeth and their overall health as well, because bacteria in a dog's mouth could actually make them sick. Cleaning their teeth can be easy and inexpensive too! Here is a recipe for home made toothpaste for pets:

- 4-6 tbsp. baking soda
- 1-2 cubes of beef bouillon
- 1 tsp dried or fresh parsley
- 1 tsp water (warm to melt bouillon)

1. Mix all ingredients together thoroughly in a small bowl.
2. Add more water as needed to make a paste.
3. Store in an airtight container and use daily with a thumb brush, pet toothbrush or a small clean rag.

An Easy Treat Recipe that Cats and Dogs both Love!

Ingredients:

- 4 Tablespoons Soft Margarine
- 1/4 Cup Warm Water
- 1/4 Cup Flour
- 5 Tablespoons Parmesan Cheese



Preheat oven to 300 degrees. Combine water, parmesan cheese, and margarine. Add flour and form a dough. Roll dough to 1/4 inch thick and cut with cookie cutter into desired shape. Bake on ungreased cookie sheet for 20-25 minutes or until cookies turn lightly golden. Makes about 1 1/2 dozen treats,
