PET LIFE CARE

If you do not have anyone you can designate as caregiver for your pets, consider setting up a pet trust with Perpetual Care. We will always be there. Cost: Varies. Visit www.perpetualcare.org for details.

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY PET CARE

When seniors require hospital or other medical facility care, we can provide daily care for their pets until they are able to return home. Cost: Free

PET SHARE AND CARE PROGRAM

For pet owners who go into a senior care facility as a resident Perpetual Care provides the daily care of the pet and we arrange for the pet to visit their owner regularly. Cost: A per visit fee to cover transportation costs and veterinary care costs.



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

1. Every day, about 6,775 people die in the United States. Only 60% of them have a will and only 7% of those include pets.
2. Every day pets are taken to animal shelters by a family member and 36%-50% of pets in shelters are euthanized.
3. A pet life care agreement gives you the comfort that a family member or friend accepts the commitment to care for your pets.
4. A will only takes effect when people pass away. A pet life care agreement provides for your pet even while you are living, but are unable to care for your pet.
5. Even if you just adopted your pet, you should protect them by setting up an estate plan today, because you never know....



HOW TO SET UP YOUR PET LIFE CARE AGREEMENT

- 1. Ask your designated primary caregiver and your secondary caregiver to commit to caring for your pets.**
- 2. Use the pet life care agreement on our website as a template and insert your own information.**
- 3. Have your attorney review your life care agreement.**
- 4. Sign the agreement and have your two caregivers sign the agreement in front of a notary.**
- 5. File the agreement with your other important documents, give a copy to your caregivers and include it in your estate plan if you have one.**
